NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: Sealed bids will be received by the School Board of the Burlington Community School District at the Administration Building, 1429 West Avenue, Burlington, Iowa 52601 before 2:00 p.m. local Iowa time, according to the designated clock in the Administration Building, on Thursday, September 5, 2024 for the Corse Early Childhood Center HVAC Upgrades project. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud after 2:00 p.m. in the Administration Building, 1429 West Avenue, Burlington, Iowa 52601.

Consideration of the bids received and the award of contracts or other action may be made by the School Board of the Burlington Community School District upon the proposals received in accordance with the law and the plans and specifications at its regular meeting anticipated at 6:00 p.m. on September 9, 2024, in the Administration Building, located at 1429 West Avenue, Burlington, Iowa 52601.

The Project consists of replacement of three (3) existing roof-mounted air-cooled condensing units and the associated piping and evaporator coils within the indoor air handling units. The new air-cooled condensing units will be placed on the existing support rails. The existing controls and interface with the Johnson Controls building automation will remain and be reused maintaining the existing sequence of operations. In addition, the variable frequency drives on the supply fans for the three (3) air handling units and the VFD on a fourth air handling unit located in a mechanical mezzanine in the northeast portion of the building will also be replaced.

Work on the Project shall commence on October 1, 2024 and shall be substantially complete by March 31, 2025.

Bids must be a lump sum basis for a single prime contract as described in the specifications.

City Blue Technologies requests Bidders order copies from their website prior to pickup. The freight cost for documents that are shipped is non-refundable, or a UPS Account number can be used in place of a check. Only one complete set of documents may be obtained per party. It is desired to reduce the number of printed sets. The Architect/Engineer invites Bidders to review the project details and digital documents to confirm their interest prior to requesting printed sets. Bidders are strongly encouraged to register at www.klingnerplanroom.com as a Prime Bidder or Sub-Contractor to ensure timely receipt of bidding documents and notices relative to this bid and be listed as a plan holder. The Owner and Architect/Engineer are NOT responsible for any incompleteness of bidding documents made available from sources other than www.klingnerplanroom.com.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Project Site at 711 S. Leebrick St., Burlington, Iowa 52601 on August 20, 2024 at 2:00 p.m. Bidders are strongly encouraged, but not required, to attend and familiarize themselves with the project site and existing conditions at that time.

Each bid shall be made on a form furnished by the Architect/Engineer and shall be sealed in an envelope. The bid bond/bid security shall be five (5) percent and submitted in a separate envelope. The bidder's security shall be in the form of a cashier's check or a certified check drawn on an FDIC insured bank in Iowa or on an FDIC insured bank chartered under the laws of the United States; or a Bid Bond on the form provided in the Contract Documents with corporate Surety satisfactory to the School Board of the Burlington Community School District. The bid shall contain no condition except as provided in the specifications. Bid security shall be made payable to the Burlington Community School District.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond both in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the total amount payable by the terms of the Contract and in accordance with other requirements outlined in the Bid Documents. These Bonds will be required of the Contractor, within ten (10) days of the issuance of the "Notice of Intent to Award".

Should the successful bidder fail or neglect to furnish satisfactory performance/payment bonds, refuse to enter into a Contract on the basis of the bid, or fail to meet the requirements of this Notice and the specifications regulating the award, the bidder's security may be retained as liquidated damages. No bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (30) calendar days after the date and hour set for opening of bids.

Bidders bear sole responsibility for ensuring bids are received timely and at the right location. Email and facsimile bids will not be accepted.

The School Board may make the contract award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder meeting specifications. The right is reserved to reject any or all bids, or any part thereof, and to waive informalities as allowed by law, and to enter into such contract or contracts as shall be deemed in the best interests of the Burlington Community School District. Additionally, the School Board reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to not proceed with the project. All bids will be governed by applicable provisions in the lowa Code and District policy.

By virtue of statutory authority, a preference will be given to products and provisions grown and/or produced within the State of Iowa.

In accordance with lowa statutes, a resident bidder shall be allowed a preference as against a nonresident bidder from a state or foreign country if that state or foreign country gives or requires any preference to bidders from that state or foreign country, including but not limited to any preference to bidders, the imposition of any type of labor force preference, or any other form of preferential treatment to bidders or laborers from that state or foreign country. The preference allowed shall be equal to the preference given or required by the state or foreign country in which the nonresident bidder is a resident. In the instance of a resident labor force preference, a nonresident bidder shall apply the same resident labor force preference to a public improvement in this state as would be required in the construction of a public improvement by the state or foreign country in which the nonresident bidder is a resident. All bidders must provide a statement regarding the bidder's resident status. This statement shall be on the Bidder Status Form designated by the Iowa Department of Labor Commissioner and available online. The statement must be signed by an authorized representative of the bidder. Failure by any bidder to provide a completed statement included in the envelope containing the bid security may result in the bid being deemed nonresponsive and rejected.
